# NOTES ON CLASSES

SUBSTITUTION OF OFFICIALS

If any official is unable to perform his/her duties, the Los Amigos Peruvian Paso Club may substitute another official in his/her place. Such substitution shall not give the exhibitor the right to a refund of any fees paid or due.

CHANGE OF CLASSES

The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel and/or change any class or condition. Changes will be posted at the show office.

HALTER CLASSES

Exhibitors will enter the class with the horse in gait, complete one full circle of the arena and line up according to the ring steward. In the line up, they will stand for conformation inspection, walk to the rail and return to the line up, according to the judge's instructions. All entries will take the rail, counter clockwise, in gait for one revolution of the arena, where they will make a loop to reverse and continue clockwise for one revolution of the arena. The judge may ask individual horses to work further.

STAKES/JACKPOT CLASSES

Class 12: Gelding Stakes, Luxury.

This class is non-qualifying. Entry fee is \$50. Los Amigos guarantees \$500 plus all entry fees included in the purse. Prizes will be paid as follows:

1st Place:	35%
2nd Place:	25%
3rd Place:	20%
4th Place:	15%
5th Place:	5%

Classes 25, 47, 51: Peruvian Reining Series.

These classes are non-qualifying. Entry fee is \$50. All entry fees will go into the jackpot for each class. Prizes will be paid as follows:

1st Place:	35%
2nd Place:	25%
3rd Place:	20%
4th Place:	15%
5th Place:	5%

Class 26: Saddle Switch Stakes Class - NEW!!

This is a non-qualifying class. Entry fee is \$50. All entry fees will go into the jackpot. Prizes to be paid as follows:

1st Place Horse Owner:	50%
1st Place Rider:	50%

Riders MUST sign release of liability upon entering class. Class consists of a lottery drawing to be held at start of class to determine which rider exhibits which horse. Exhibitors enter arena on horseback, each rider draws a horse number, riders to re-draw if the chosen horse is the horse they are entered on, or one they own.

# NOTES ON CLASSES

Class 26: Saddle Switch Stakes Class *(continued)*

Show Management may re-draw a horse number for a rider if they draw a horse they regularly exhibit in competition. 5 minutes will be given for riders to mount their new horses, two warm up laps will be allowed at start of class. Horses entered should be proven performance horses, with training & ability to complete normal performance class maneuvers. Judged 40% on equitation and capability of rider, 40% performance, brio, suitability and manners, 20% gait and smoothness.

Class 44: Los Amigos Member To Ride, Performance.

This is a qualifying class. Entry fee is \$50. \$40 of each entry fee will go into a jackpot for prize money and be paid as follows:

1st Place:	45%
2nd Place:	35%
3rd Place:	20%

## JUNIOR CLASSES

12 & Under: 2, 22, 31, 41, 56. • 13 & Over: 3, 23, 32, 42, 58.

Junior classes' age groups may be combined at the discretion of the show management. Ribbons and awards will still be awarded for each class. Helmets for Juniors 12 years of age and under are required.

Classes 22 & 23: No ponchos are allowed. Jackets are ok.

Classes 31 & 32: Bareback pads are allowed. Ponchos and jackets are not allowed.

Classes 41 & 42: Juniors have two minutes to execute a pattern of their own making.

The pattern must include: walk, gait, stop, stand, back up and circle in both directions. No tricks are permitted (see NAPHA rules for clarification). No ponchos or jackets.

Classes 56 & 58: Judged on the grooming and conditioning of the horse. Horses are presented in hand and are brought into the arena at a walk and line up in the center of the ring. The judge may ask exhibitors about, but are not limited to, the Peruvian Horse's conformation, gait, equitation and/or unique qualities.

## ALTERNATIVE ATTIRE FOR PERFORMANCE DIVISIONS - IT'S BACK!

Both the Amateur and Open Performance divisions are open to "alternative attire".

This is NOT mandatory, rather an option.

Guidelines for alternative attire are:

- Hat must be of Peruvian style as outlined by NAPHA rules.
- Blazer or suit-style vest MUST be worn. Bolero jackets ok.
- No ponchos.
- Boots/belts in colors are outlined in NAPHA rules. Boots may be worn outside of pants.
- Slacks/pants must be long enough to cover ankle and boot tops.
- Split skirts or sidesaddle aprons for women as outlined in NAPHA rules.
- Shirts must be collared, long-sleeve as per NAPHA rules.
- Scarves/ties include traditional Peruvian white scarf, bolo tie, western crisscross tie, necktie or brooch.

# NOTES ON CLASSES

ALTERNATIVE ATTIRE *(continued)*

Colors allowed are:

- Black • Shades of Grey (charcoal to light)
- Browns (dark to tan/beige, khaki) • Shades of Muted Greens (olive to hunter)
- Blues (light to dark navy) • Burgundies (no bright reds or pinks)
- White • Creams • Ivory • NO BLUE DENIM

Small pinstripes for jackets as outlined in NAPHA rules is acceptable.

## AMATEUR PERFORMANCE CLASSES

Riders showing in any Amateur class must have a Declaration of Amateur Status on file with the NAPHA. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor (not the horse show office) to have this form signed in advance of entering any Amateur classes. If this is not completed, you may be required to forfeit any winnings and awards. Forms are available in the show office and from NAPHA.

Class 36 must be ridden by the Amateur Owner of the horse and only qualify for the Amateur Performance Championship class appropriate to the horse's gender.

## OPEN PERFORMANCE CLASSES

Classes 5, 7, 18, 39 and 60 are open to both Amateurs and Professionals. They all qualify for the Performance Championship class appropriate to the horse's gender. If the horse is ridden by an Amateur, the horse will also qualify for the Amateur Performance Championship class appropriate to the horse's gender.

Classes 18, 27, 29, 34 and 44 only qualify for the Performance Championship class appropriate to the horse's gender.

## NOVICE CLASSES

Novice classes (9, 20) are for Amateur riders 18+ years of age. Horses must be in the bit, 4+ years of age. Riders must not have won more than 5 first place ribbons at any Los Amigos Championship Show.

## NON-PERUVIAN TACK & ATTIRE CLASS

This class will be judged as a Performance class. The tack and attire used may be anything other than Peruvian and the tack and attire must match. For example, if the attire is Western, the tack must also be Western. If the tack is Spanish, the attire must also be Spanish. However, the use of the Peruvian bit is allowed with any tack and attire. 40% performance, 15% manners, 15% gait and collection, 15% brio and 15% tack and attire.

## CONJUNTO CLASSES

Entries may be shown in bit or bozal. Classes are judged with Breeding Division rules.

Class 48: An entry consists of 2-3 horses out of the same dam.

Class 49: An entry consists of 3-4 horses owned and/or bred by one ranch/breeder.

Class 50: An entry consists of 3-4 horses by the same sire.

## BEST GAITED HORSE OF SHOW & RESERVE

Class 66 is open to the 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 28, 30, 33, 35, 40 and 43.

# NOTES ON CLASSES

## CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

First and second place horses in qualifying classes will be eligible to enter their respective Championship classes. However, they are not required to show in the Championship Class. If entering, they must be entered and the fee paid prior to these classes on Sunday.

## CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS CLASSES

Champion of Champions Classes are open to previous Champions of a Los Amigos Show and all NAPHA National Champion of Champions (including AAOBPPH & PPHRNA). Returning Champions may enter qualifying classes but if they fail to re-qualify, they are not eligible to enter the Champion of Champions classes based upon their status as returning Champion. Returning Champions must be entered in their respective Champion of Champions class before 7/22/11, 9:00 AM.

When entering a returning Champion into the Champion of Champions class, please note how the horse is qualified to enter (e.g. "2010 National Champion of Champions"). The fee for horses only entering a Champion of Champions class in the entire show is \$75.

## PERUVIAN REINING SERIES - IT'S BACK!!

After much thought and consideration on how to maintain the traditions of the Peruvian Horse, we have developed the "Peruvian Reining Series". These are three classes, levels one (bit and bozal), two and three, that allow a wide range to horse and rider ability. The difficulty of the required maneuvers at each level increases, with level three having the required movements of the enfrenadura.

This year, to assist the judge in better assessing performances, all maneuvers must be done in the order listed. Please visit [lappc.org](http://lappc.org) for a complete listing of rules, guidelines and judges cards.

## MUSIC

Music is optional. No extra points are given for music. Music on a CD must be provided to the Show Announcer no less than one day before the class.

## ENTRIES

A horse may only enter one level but a rider may enter multiple levels, provided they are riding a different horse each time. A rider may show multiple horses in the same level.

## END OF YEAR HIGH POINTS

Multiple shows are offering the Peruvian Reining Series. There will be two Annual High Point Awards, given to the Professional and Amateur that have accumulated the highest average score from all Peruvian Reining Series at the shows they exhibit at. A minimum of 3 scores is required.

## LEVEL ONE

Horses in the bozal class may be 3-4 years of age and horses in the bit class, 4+ years old. The use of two hands on the reins is allowed for bit horses but two hands for bozal horses is required. Riding with two hands will not be penalized. The horse must execute the paso llano at all times. Tack and attire for bozal entries are the same as other bozal classes and for the bit entries, they're the same as all Performance classes. Maximum time: 3 minutes.

## LEVEL ONE *(continued)* Required Maneuvers:

Circle in both directions (10 m.)

Caracole (begin w/15 m. circle). 3 revolutions to one direction

Cuarteo one revolution in the center of the caracole

Open caracole

Figure 8

Stop and stand for at least 5 seconds

Back at least 5 steps

## Optional Maneuvers:

Circle in either direction (5 m.)

## LEVEL TWO

Only bit horses 4+ years of age are allowed. The use of one or two hands on the reins is permitted but the rider be consistent throughout the entire class. The horse must execute the paso llano at all times. Tack and attire is the same as all Performance classes at this show. Maximum time: 4 1/2 minutes.

## Required Maneuvers:

Circle in both directions (5 m.)

Caracole (begin w/15 m. circle). 3 revolutions

Cuarteo one revolution in the center of the caracole

Open caracole with 3 revolutions

Repeat caracole/cuarteo/open caracole in opposite direction

2 figure 8s

Stop for at least 5 seconds

Back at least 10 steps

## Optional Maneuvers:

Surge

Touch horse's nose to stirrup at the inside of the caracole

## LEVEL THREE

Only bit horses 4+ year of age are allowed. Rienda pareja is preferred, but rienda coja is permitted. Unless otherwise specified, the horse must execute the paso llano. Required tack and attire includes traditional Peruvian "whites", Peruvian saddle, pella, spurs and a poncho folded and placed on saddle. Maximum time: 6 minutes.

## Required Maneuvers:

Circle in both directions (15 m.)

Caracole (begin w/15 m. circle). 3 revolutions

Cuarteo one revolution in the center of the caracole

Touch horse's nose to the stirrup 3 times during cuarteo

Open caracole with 3 revolutions

Repeat caracole/cuarteo/open caracole in opposite direction

2 figure 8s

While in Figure 8s, touch horse's nose to stirrup 3 times, in each direction

Stop and stand for at least 5 seconds

Back at least 15 steps

Figure 6 in either direction at a gallop

## Optional Maneuvers:

Surge

Walk while touching horse's nose to stirrup in both directions

# NOTES ON CLASSES

## GAITED DRESSAGE CLASSES - IT'S BACK!!

Sunday morning, we will be conducting three Gaited Dressage classes, officiated by German Baca. These classes are non-qualifying and open to all riders.

## ENTRIES

A horse may be entered in one, two or three of these classes; there are no restrictions. Also, riders may enter the same class on multiple horses if they so desire. All horses must be 4+ years of age and in the bit.

## READERS

Exhibitors may have a reader for any of the classes. Readers must be arranged by the rider themselves.

## TACK & ATTIRE

Performance division tack and attire is acceptable. Also accepted are dressage tack and attire, as outlined by USDF/USEF. If dressage tack is used, a Peruvian or snaffle bit may be used.

## INTRO LEVEL

In this class, the Judge will be looking for a steady, straight, relaxed horse. Transitions and circles should be fluid. Paso llano and walk are required.

## TRAINING LEVEL

Here, the Judge will be looking for a steady, straight, relaxed horse that is also able stay on the bit. Transitions, of course, are important in scoring. Paso llano and walk are required.

## LEVEL 1

This is the only class that requires lateral work. The Judge will be looking for the same qualities as the intro and training level horses as well as a horse that easily accepts the aids. Walk, paso llano and sobreandando are required.

# SPECIAL AWARDS

## CONQUISTADOR CUP

This trophy is awarded to the high point stallion or mare for zootecnico, gait and breeding classes (classes 8, 10, 17, 19, 28, 30, 40, 43, 55, 62). The horse must enter all three classes to qualify.

## HIGH POINT JUNIORS

A High Point Junior and Reserve High Point Junior will be awarded for each of the two Junior age groups: 12- (classes 2, 22, 31, 41, 56) and 13+ (3, 23, 32, 42, 58). Classes 13-15 do not count towards these high point awards.

## HIGH POINT NOVICE OF SHOW

This is awarded to the novice that accumulated the highest number of points in the Novice division (classes 9, 20) as well one of the following classes: 5, 7, 11, 16, 46.

## HIGH POINT RANCH OF SHOW

This award is given to the complete registered owner whose horses have accumulated the highest number of points in all non-Championship classes except for Junior and conjunto classes.

## HIGH POINT AMATEUR OF SHOW

This is awarded to the amateur that accumulated the highest number of points in classes 11, 16, 18, 39, 46 and 60.

## HIGH POINT TIES

For all of the aforementioned awards, any ties will be broken by the number of 1st, 2nds, 3rd, etc. won.

## BEST DECORATED BARN

This is awarded to the most elegantly decorated barn by the Show Management.

# RULES & REGULATIONS

## DRUG FREE SHOW

This is a drug free show. No drugs of any kind may be given to any horse. All entered horses are subject to examination by a licensed vet or drug testing technician. The State of California will send an inspector. Random testing may be done and may include saliva, urine and/or blood tests, at the discretion of the examiner. Each exhibitor agrees that any horse testing positive for a drug will forfeit all prizes, places and points awarded at this show. Refusal to submit a horse for examination and/or to cooperate with officials subjects the person to the penalties under the rules.

## RESPONSIBILITY

Los Amigos Peruvian Paso Club and its members, show officials, NAPHA, SCPPHC and the Earl Warren Showgrounds will not be held responsible for any loss, personal injury, or damage to horses exhibited, or for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost or destroyed or in any way damaged.

## DOGS

Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times. Dogs will not be allowed in buildings or in arenas. It is the policy of the Showgrounds to allow animal control to come on the grounds throughout the year to pick up those dogs not on a leash. Any dog owner whose dog is caught loose on the Showgrounds, is subject to a \$25 fine for the first offense and \$50 for the second offense. A third offense will result in expulsion from the Showgrounds.

## SAFETY & CONDUCT

Smoking and parking signs must be obeyed. No smoking in the barn. Dogs must be on a leash. Exhibitors disregarding these rules may be excused from the Showgrounds by the Show Management.

Any exhibitor making remarks considered offensive or made with the intent to influence or cast aspersions on the judging may be barred from the show. Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials by an owner, groom, rider, handler or member of the family of persons participating in the show may disqualify them or their horses from judging. Any person appearing to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol may be banned from further showing and/or may be asked to leave the Showgrounds. The Show Management reserves the right to remove any of the aforementioned persons from the show without being liable for compensation for damages.

Entries may be faxed or mailed to the Show Secretary. Do not fax entries after Monday, July 18. Entries may be mailed to the Show Secretary, Arlynda Castro, 3830 Douglas Drive, Santa Rosa, CA 95405. Entries must be received before Friday, July 15. No exhibitor numbers will be released without full payment or deposit of open check with horse show office.

## LATE ENTRY FEE

No late fees will be incurred if the horse is entered in one or more classes before the end of the day, Friday, July 15, 2011. Additional class entries for a horse already entered in the show may be made, up to two classes before the class to be entered. No late fees for post entries. All fees credited/returned if the horse is cancelled from any class, provided the cancellation is made in writing (change sheets) and one class before the class to be cancelled. Vet certificate not required to cancel classes but is required for refund of any class not cancelled and/or the horse did not enter the arena.

# NOTES ON ENTRIES

## RETURNING CHAMPIONS

When entering a returning Champion into the Champion of Champions class, please note how the horse is qualified to enter (e.g. "2010 National Champion of Champions"). The fee for horses only entering a Champion of Champions class in the entire show is \$75.

## SUBSTITUTION OF ENTRIES/REFUND

If a horse is entered and then unable to perform, another horse may be substituted. Refunds will be considered only if a veterinarian certificate is submitted to the Show Secretary before the close of the show. The Show Managers have the final authority on refunds. No refunds will be approved until after the close of the show.

## OFFICE FEE

If a horse is entered, with or without fees, and then withdrawn from competition for any reason, the office fee will still apply.

## ENTRY FORM

One per owner of horse/s. Multiple entries by same exhibitor does not qualify as "per owner of horse/s". Must be signed by the registered owner of the horses. Agents may only sign if agent form (or copy) is provided with entry.

## REGISTRATION PAPERS

All entries must include a copy of the current registration papers for each horse. Papers must be issued from NAPHA or NAPHA-approved registries, in accordance with NAPHA show approval guidelines. All male horses, shown in any bit class must provide registration papers indicating Stallion or Gelding, as outlined in NAPHA rules.

## RESPONSIBILITY

It is the responsibility of the owner or agent of each horse to complete the entry form in full. Each change of class, rider or handler should be made on a supplemental entry form provided at the show office. No horses should enter any classes without submission of these forms and fees paid in advance (or open check on file).
